

The activity aims to encourage the youth (ages 13–18) to promote local literature in their communities through a short film contest.

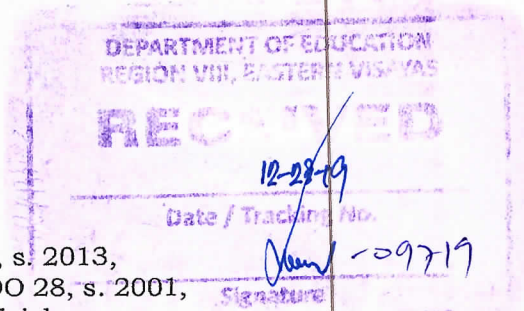
The target participants are secondary students from public schools.
