The details and speaker of each training are attached in this letter.

Therefore, at the end of the training, the participants are expected to come up with a proposal which is ready for implementation. Also, all the participants will have the chance to prepare an abstract to be submitted to any conferences here and abroad. This will be a big opportunity for the participants to experience research which is hands-on especially those who are advising candidates for thesis and dissertation writing, those enrolling in the graduate school programs, and those who are teaching Practical Research in the Senior High School.

The regular registration fee of the said training workshops is Php6,500.00 (for a 3-day training) and Php5,500.00 (for a 2-day training) inclusive of the following: training kit, training hand-outs, training certificates, lunch and snacks, but excludes hotel accommodation. Be it noted that this permit is valid only for SY 2019-2020 and shall be subject to revocation should the aforementioned institution fail to operate according to the standards setforth by the Secretary of the Department of Education and other educational laws governing curriculum offering. It is further stipulated that the permitherein conferred does not extend to any branch of the said school whether located in the same municipality or city, or in other municipalities or cities.

It is hereby reminded that said school shall apply for renewal of permit for the ensuing school year of legitimate and satisfactory operation with the Office of the Regional Director. However, the permit previously issued is deemed considered renewed and continue to be valid during the period the said school has already filed its application for Government Recognition (DO 11, s. 2011).
