The Department of Education (DepEd) through the External Partnerships Service (EPS), and in coordination with Disaster Risk Reduction Management Service (DRRMS), is engaging our private sector partners in generating support for affected schools, including the learners and personnel due to the eruption of Taal Volcano in Batangas. Attached is the situation report prepared by the DRRMS for your information.

The EPS is also engaging and coordinating with our public sector and DepEd field offices to ensure efficient generation and mobilization of resources to support the ongoing disaster response and rehabilitation of affected schools in CALABARZON especially in Batangas and Cavite.

In coordination with the DRRMS, the Regional and Schools Division Offices (ROs and SDOs) are enjoined to raise and mobilize private partners support in your respective schools divisions to provide immediate needs of learners and personnel such as food items, standard hygiene kits, teacher's kits, learner's kits and cleaning kits. To ensure effective and efficient generation of donations and avoid duplication or "over donation" of any of the aforementioned items – an itemized list of the content of the said kits and the suggested items to be donated by each region is hereto attached for your reference.

The ROs and SDOs shall assign donation drop off areas in their respective offices or conduct other activities to generate donation items. The resource generation and mobilization period shall be from January 20 to February 15, 2020.

Further, the ROs and SDOs shall directly send the donations to the concerned schools divisions through Mr. Bernardo C. Pascual or Mr. Wilbert C. Ulpindo of DepEd CALABARZON. Contact details are provided in the attachment.
