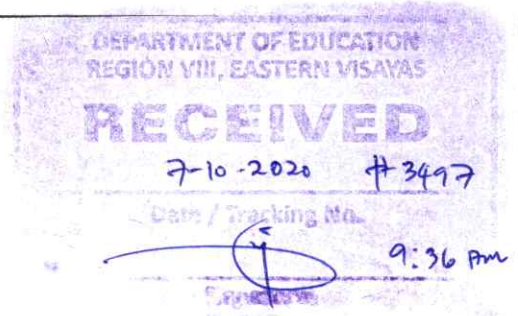

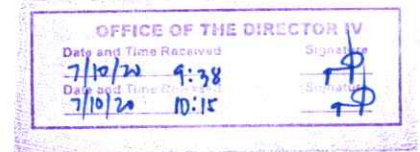

This is to inform your good office that in light of the present health crisis that the whole world is experiencing which greatly affects the way education will be delivered to learners, DepEd Catbalogan City Division has been working for initiatives that would help ensure effective delivery of instruction comes August 24, 2020. Recently, it has launched its EduKatbalogan BayaniHands Project which spells out all its activities geared toward achieving oneness of all its stakeholders in attaining its goals and objectives amidst this pandemic.

One of the major concerns that EduKatbalogan BayaniHands Project has laid out is putting in place the learning delivery process that would serve as guide to the school heads in their implementation of activities for the new normal in schools. **DIVISION TRAINING FOR RADIO AND TELEVISION-BASED INSTRUCTION

1. Amidst this COVID-19 pandemic, this Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division, has laid down mechanisms to ensure that the basic right to education of every learner is delivered. These mechanisms are established in its *EdeKathalogan Bayanilanda Learning Delivery Process* which address distance learning modality.
2. Radio and Television-Based Instructions play major roles in delivering the distance learning modality as they will compliment learning of the lessons in the printed modules to be distributed to the learners.
3. In connection thereof, this Division will conduct a Training for Radio and Television-Based Instruction Facilitators to be made in three batches on July 14-15, July 16-17 and July 21-22 respectively at the Division Office' Atrium.
4. In this training, each participant should:
  - a. be equipped with the knowledge and skills needed in radio and television-based instruction delivery;
  - b. develop awareness on the actual running of a radio/tv program, the tools and equipment used and the production crew that will be present during broadcast;
  - c. articulate on the value attached to educational broadcasting.
5. Attached is the list of teachers and supervisors as participants in the training to be conducted in 3 batches to ensure that the minimum health protocols will be observed.
6. Expenses incurred for this activity shall be charged to HRTD/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.
