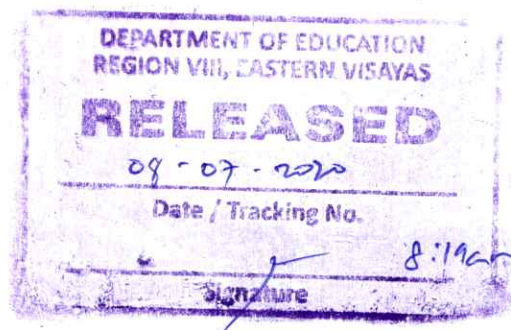

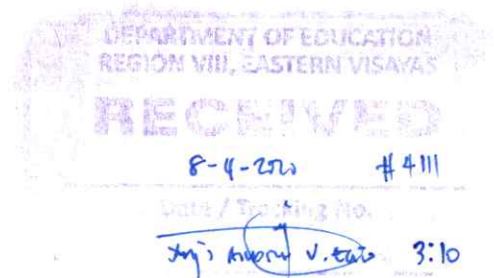

In line with the on-going project of the Department of Education (DepEd) with the United Nations Children’s Fund (UNICEF-Philippines) and Habi Education Lab entitled “Development of Blended Teacher Training Program for the Alternative Learning System”, the ALS Task Force (ATF) will conduct a **National Training of Trainers on Facilitating Blended Learning Experiences** on **August 11 to 13, 2020 via Zoom**.

This training aims to upskill virtual facilitation and online learning management competence of the ALS Trainers/Implementers for effective and appropriate blended teacher training program.

Specifically, after this training, participants will be able to:

1. Understand the basics of learning experience design, and what it means for facilitation;
2. Identify the design principles of good online teacher training;
3. Know the best practices and challenges about online facilitation;
4. Facilitate engaging online teacher training sessions;
5. Adopt content and session guides to fit the context of learners and facilitation;

6. Give importance to empathizing with learner's experience; and
7. Feel confident in using technology platforms for online facilitation.

Training allowances for all participants will be charged against the 2020 FLO-ALS Current Fund to be downloaded to the Regional Offices (ROs) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
