2. hold competitions such as short film, data visualization, online arts contest, puzzle of the day and week to high school students to showcase their talents.

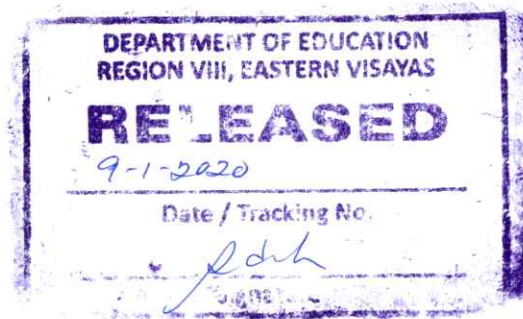

II. Online Seminar for Teachers

Teachers from any secondary school (private or public) nationwide are highly encouraged to join. This is a FREE Online Seminar that will mainly focus on the fundamentals of online classes, how to sustain it, and how to keep the class secure. The online seminar will be streamed on October 18, 2020 (Sunday) at the UPLB Mathematical Sciences Society Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/uplbmass1973>). To recognize a teacher's attendance, he/she must send screenshots of at least 3 slides from the highlighted slides of the presented PowerPoint Presentation together with his/her Name, School, and School Address to our email address (admin@uplbmass.org) or to our Facebook page. Once the participation is verified, the teacher will receive a certificate issued by the organization.

III. Short Film Contest

Students from any secondary school (private or public) nationwide are qualified to join the contest. Each school must be represented by at most one team, which will be composed of at most five students and one teacher each. A maximum of 30 teams will be allowed to join. Five finalists will be selected from the participating entries. These five entries shall be uploaded in the organization's Facebook page a day before the announcement of winners. Whoever gets the highest score among the finalists will be considered the Grand Winner.

Registration

- This is a free-of-charge contest.
- The participating team should come up with a team name. To register, they have to fill out a form. They will be required to send a certification stating that they are the official representative of their school duly signed by the principal. The duly accomplished form and the certification shall be sent to a certain email address until September 28, 2020, Monday, 11:59 PM. An acknowledgement email shall be received which signifies a successful registration.
- Only those people listed in the registration form are allowed to do the creative endeavors of the film including (but not limited to) scriptwriting, editing, musical scoring, and directing. If someone, who is not part of the team, helps in the creative endeavors of the film, the said team will be disqualified.
- Submitting the form shall mean that the team/s agree to follow the rules of the competition and the film guidelines and respect the decision of the panel of judges. It shall also mean that the organization is allowed to insert short advertisements and play the video that they will submit publicly.
- UPLB MASS reserves the right to disqualify any team that will not adhere to the given guidelines. Also, the organization reserves the right to change and amend

the competition rules given that there's enough time to disseminate the information changes.

Contest Proper

- The video can be a short film, an animation, or a documentary.
- The film shall be related to this year's Mathematical Sciences Week theme.
- Any gadget (phone, DSLR, digital camera) can be used to shoot the film. Animation and computer graphics are also allowed.
- The film should only last for 5-10 minutes including the introduction and credits. Any lack or excess on the time shall have the appropriate deductions.
- The video can come in either English or Filipino language. The teams are encouraged to put subtitles.
- The video should not include any offensive or inappropriate language or content. The video shall be applicable for general viewership.
- The teams are encouraged to come up with an original score. However, if pre-recorded music will be used, make sure that it is properly cited to avoid any copyright issue. Hence, it is also discouraged to include switched -on televisions and radio in the background.
- The film must be in .mp4 or .avi format and in high definition.
- The film shall be submitted through a personal google drive link that will be sent to you after registration. Take note that this Google Drive link is exclusive for your team and only the one who submitted the registration form will have access to it.
- The final copy of the film should be submitted on or before October 7, 2020, 11:59 PM to give the judges an ample amount of time to critique the film.
- Only those films received on or before the deadline shall be considered official participants. Those who fail to submit their films on the said deadline will be disqualified to join the competition.
- Failure to follow the said rules may result in disqualification.
- The participating schools will be ranked by the judges according to the criteria presented.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

Criteria for Judging:

Entries will be judged using the following criteria:

Relevance to theme	-	30%
Originality	-	20%

Finalists: E-Certificates of Recognition and PhP 500 cash

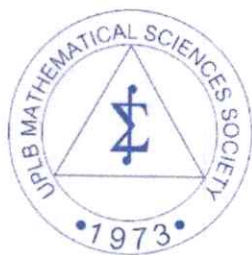
- The winners will be announced via Facebook live on the organization's page on October 21, 2020. The Top 3 films will also be streamed.

IV. Data Visualization Competition

High school and college students (public or private) nationwide are qualified to join the competition. The competition will be divided into two categories: high school category and college category. A maximum of 25 participants or entries will be accommodated in each category. Among all the entries, top 5 entries in each category will be chosen as finalists. The top 5 entries in each category shall be posted on the organization's Facebook page a day before the announcement of winners.

Registration

- This contest is free of charge.
- Participants should register by filling out a Google forms link until October 1, 2020, 11:59 PM. They will be required to upload their ID or certification of enrollment upon registration.

Contest Proper

- Each participant can submit one (1) entry only.
- Infographic submissions should demonstrate this year's Mathematical Sciences Week theme.
- Infographics must be submitted in English language.
- The size of the infographic should exactly be 11x17 inches.
- Entries should be submitted in PDF, PNG, or JPEG file formats in the highest possible resolution.
- An entry must be the participant's original work. It must not infringe on another person's copyright, trademark, or any intellectual property right.
- Data and information used must be properly cited.
- Entries may not contain materials that are sexually explicit, defamatory, libelous, indecent, obscene, or other inappropriate content.
- The infographics shall be submitted through a personal Google Drive link that will be sent to the participant after registration.
- The deadline of submission of entries is on October 9, 2020, 11:59PM.
- Only those entries received on or before the deadline shall be considered official participants. Those who fail to submit their entries on the said deadline will be disqualified to join the competition.
- Failure to follow the rules may result in deduction of points or disqualification.
- The infographics shall be judged based on the rubric.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

Prizes and Announcement of Winners

V. Online Arts Contest

Any bona fide UPLB student can participate in this contest. Only a maximum of 50 entries will be accommodated. This art contest may be online, but it is not only limited to digital arts since the entries shall be judged using a certain criteria. From the 50 entries, 15 finalists will be selected. The entries of these finalists will be posted on the organization's Facebook page a day before the announcement of winners.

Registration

- This competition is free of charge.
- Participants should register by filling out a Google Forms link until September 28, 2020, 11:59 PM. They will be required to upload their ID or certification of enrollment upon registration.
- Submitting the form shall mean that the participant agrees to follow the rules of the competition and the contest guidelines and respect the decision of the panel of judges. It shall also mean that the organization is allowed to post the artwork that they will submit publicly.

Contest Proper

- A participant can submit at most one entry only.
- The entry shall be related to this year's Mathematical Sciences Week theme.
- The entry can be a digital art, traditional art, or a combination of the two.
- The entry shall not exceed 20 MB in size.
- The entry shall be the participant's original work.
- The entry shall not contain any copyrighted material.
- The entry shall not contain watermarks and date stamps.
- The entry shall be accompanied by a title and brief explanation. The explanation can either be in English or Filipino language and shall only be composed of a maximum of 5 sentences.
- The brief explanation must be in PDF form and must include the participant's name, student number, degree program, entry title, and the explanation itself.
- The entry (in JPEG file format) and the explanation (in PDF file format) shall be submitted through a personal Google Drive link that will be sent to you after registration. (Note: This Google Drive link is exclusive to the participant and only the email address used during the registration will have access to it.) An acknowledgement e-mail will be sent which signifies a successful entry.
- The entry shall be submitted on or before October 10, 2020, 11:59 PM.
- Only those entries received on or before the deadline shall be considered official. Those who fail to submit their entries on the said deadline will be disqualified to join the competition.
- Failure to follow the rules may result in deduction of points or disqualification.
- The entries shall be judged based on the rubric.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

To spice things up, a difficult puzzle will also be posted on the first day of the Mathematical Sciences Week. The well-screened puzzles will come from certain topics under Computer Science, Mathematics, and Statistics. Winners for the Puzzle of the Day will be announced at 8:00 P.M. during the same day, whereas the winner for the Puzzle of the Week will be announced on October 23, 2020.

General Guidelines

- The posts for each Puzzle shall include a Google Form link for students who wish to participate. The form includes:
 - Participant's Name
 - Participant's Contact Information
 - The Puzzle
 - A space for the participant's answer
- The winner shall be randomly chosen from the people who have obtained the correct answer within the given time period.
- The organization shall post the winner, alongside the solution to the puzzle at exactly 8:00 P.M. on the same day the Puzzle of the Day was posted. The winner for the Puzzle of the Week will be announced on October 23, 2020.

VII. Hackathon

A hackathon is a programming competition or a coding challenge for aspiring developers to solve a given problem. The goal of a hackathon is to solve a problem over the course of the event and create a fully functioning usable software by the end of the event. Anyone aged 16-25 can join this competition. In order to participate, a team must have a maximum of three members and a minimum of one member. A participant must be a part of one team only. A maximum of eight teams are allowed to register. Among the eight teams, only one team will be considered the grand winner.

Registration

- This competition is free of charge.
- Registration forms shall be publicized on the registration period which will take place from October 5, 2020 to October 7, 2020.
- Submitting the form shall mean that the participant agrees to follow the rules of the competition and the contest guidelines and respect the decision of the panel of judges.
- UPLB MASS reserves the right to disqualify any team that will not follow the said guidelines. The organization also reserves the right to change and amend the competition rules given that there's enough time to disseminate the information changes.

Contest Proper

- The software made must be related to this year's Mathematical Science Week theme.
- Participants must submit the following on or before the deadline:
 - ESSAY: the document explains the idea behind the software and must also include the features of it. The essay should follow the format:
 - Paper size: Letter
 - Font style: Times New Roman
 - Font size: 12
 - Spacing: 1.5
 - Alignment: Justified
 - Margin: 1-inch on all sides
 - Maximum of 1,000 words

- VIDEO: the length of the video must be 5-8 minutes only and must show the different aspects of the software made
- NECESSARY FILES: necessary files must include the code and the design used to completely run the software and should be compiled in a .zip file
- The required files shall be submitted through a personal Google Drive link that will be sent to the participant after registration.
- All of the required files should be submitted on or before October 15, 2020, 11:59 PM.
- Only those entries received on or before the deadline shall be considered official participants. Those who fail to submit their entries on the said deadline will be disqualified to join the competition.
- Failure to follow the rules may result in deduction of points or disqualification.
- The software made will be judged based on the rubric.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
