ASSIGNMENTS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS RELATIVE TO COMPLIAN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION WITH THE PROVISIONS UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11494 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BAYANIHAN TO RECOVER AS ONE ACT

- On September 11, 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte signed Republic Act No. 11494 also known as the Bayanihan to Recover as One Act wherein a number of DepEd-related provisions have to be complied with taking cognizance of the effectivity of the law until the next adjournment of the Eighteenth Congress on December 19, 2020.
- This Office Memorandum is issued to announce the Assignments of Executive Committee (ExeCom) Members Relative to Compliance of DepEd with the Provisions Under Republic Act No. 11494 Otherwise Known as the Bayanihan to Recover as One Act.
- To ensure expeditious implementation of actions required by these provisions, the assignment of tasks and responsibilities of the following ExeCom members shall cover the following:

- 4. Moreover, the ExeCom members are directed to:
 - a. exercise functional oversight in the execution of work plans to deliver the requirements of the law;
 - b. submit periodic reports to the Secretary for information, review and further directions on compliance with the provisions as herein stated:
 - recommend to the Secretary any critical ways and means to ensure successful implementation of tasks and responsibilities; and
 - d. coordinate and collaborate with any official and personnel of DepEd or any agency or instrumentality for any assistance that may be necessary to address and fulfill the provisions of the law.
- 5. The Office of the President, through the Office of the Executive Secretary, issued a Memorandum dated October 1, 2020 directing all heads of executive departments to submit to the Office of the Executive Secretary a Monthly Consolidated Report on or before the last working day of every month, together with the weekly summaries of acts performed to implement R.A. No. 11494, including the utilization of funds. In connection with this, all ExeCom members indicated above are directed to **submit a monthly report with weekly summaries of accomplishments** in terms of programs, strategies, plans, or activities undertaken in relation to their respective assignments using the enclosed templates prescribed by the Office of the Executive Secretary, **on or before the last Tuesday of every month**, for consolidation by the Office of the Undersecretary for Finance and final review by the Office of the Secretary.
- 6. This Memorandum shall take effect immediately upon approval, and it shall remain in full force and effect until the adjournment of the 18th Congress.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

Pursuant to Section 14 of Republic Act No. 11494 or the "Bayanihan to Recover as One Act," all heads of executive departments, agencies, instrumentalities, GOCCs, and GFIs are DIRECTED to submit to this Office on or before 6:00 p.m. of 02 October 2020 (Friday) a Consolidated Report for the month of September on the actual accomplishments of programs, strategies, plans or activities undertaken in accordance with RA No. 11494 since its effectivity last 15 September 2020.

Thereafter, a Monthly Consolidated Report will be submitted on or before the last working day of every month together with the weekly summaries of acts performed to implement RA No. 11494, including the utilization of funds.

To ensure uniformity of the data to be reported, and to facilitate compliance with the reportorial requirement under RA No. 11494, the monthly consolidated report shall contain the following:

- a) An executive summary containing the highlights of the report (see Annex A for reference);
- b) Summary of accomplishments in terms of programs or activities undertaken, and categorized based on the COVID-19 response and recovery interventions provided under Section 4 of RA No. 11494, which must provide the number of target beneficiaries and actual number of beneficiaries served, areas covered, if applicable, budget allocation and actual amount utilized (see Annex B for reference);
- c) Summary of loans entered into pursuant to RA No. 11494 with the corresponding details on the amount of loan, disbursement and salient features of the terms and conditions of the loan agreement, if applicable (see Annex C for reference);
- d) As may be applicable, funds augmented, reprogrammed, reallocated and realigned with corresponding justifications and deliverables; and
- e) Such other crucial information that would ensure that members of Congress, the COA and the public in general are kept abreast of the Government's response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The above monthly report and weekly summaries shall be sent electronically, in editable portable document format (PDF), to bayanihanreports@gmail.com.
