CURRICULUM GUIDES (CGs) AND MOST ESSENTIAL SUBJECT

LEARNING COMPETENCIES (MELCs) FOR THE SPECIAL

CURRICULAR PROGRAMS (SCPs)

SEPTEMBER 16, 2020 DATE

The adoption of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) as prescribed in DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2020, serves as the overall framework for School Year 2020-2021 as a guiding principle to achieve quality education under the framework of Sulong Edukalidad and Future Thinking Education.

The process by which the K to 12 Curriculum is streamlined into the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) for the Special Curricular Programs, was the same process undertaken by the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD).

In view of the current situation brought about by COVID-19 Pandemic, and to ensure that education continues despite the crisis where no face-to-face instruction is allowed until a vaccine becomes available, the Curriculum and Instruction (CI) Strand issues this Memorandum as a rejoinder to the aforementioned DepEd Order which is intended for the implementing schools of the Special Curricular Programs (SCPs) across the seventeen (17) regions as follows:

- Special Program in the Arts (SPA)
- Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)
- Special Program in Journalism (English and Filipino)
- Special Program in Sports (SPS)
- Special Program in Technical-Vocational Education (SPTVE)
- Special Science Program (SSP)

However, in recognition of the variations in the implementation of the *Special Science Program (SSP)* in the form of enhancements such as offering additional subjects or additional competencies and time allocated to the subject, the identification of the MELCS is left to the implementing school (refer to Annex A of the Guidelines on the Use of MELCs).
