VIRTUAL ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON THE UNIFICATION OF IDENTIFIED MOST ESSENTIAL LEARNING COMPETENCIES AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF SELF-LEARNING MODULES FOR THE ADD-ON SUBJECTS UNDER THE SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, AND ENGINEERING PROGRAM

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, shall conduct a Virtual Orientation-Workshop on the Unification of the Identified Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) and the Development of Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) for the Add-on Subjects under the Science, Technology, and Engineering (STE) Program on November 17 - 19, 2020.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. present the identified MELCs of the add-on subjects under the STE Program;
 - b. unify the identified MELCs of the add-on subjects offered by all implementing STE schools in the region;
 - c. orient the STE add-on subject teachers on the development and quality assurance of SLMs;
 - d. plan and assign tasks in the development SLMs for the STE add-on subjects; and
 - e. address other issues, gaps, and concerns related to STE Program implementation.
3. The participants to this activity are the Regional LRMS Education Program Supervisor (EPS), regional and division EPSs or focal persons of the STE Program, school heads or coordinators, and add-on subject teachers of STE-implementing schools.
4. The teacher-participants are required to have a copy of their school-identified competencies or syllabus of the add-on subjects assigned to them.
5. The activity meeting access shall be shared through the Facebook messenger to the division EPSs who will then relay the meeting link to the other participants in the division.



6. A virtual planning meeting by the regional and division STE Program Coordinators shall be conducted on November 12, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. to 12 p.m. to discuss the different activities and assignments for the said orientation-workshop.
7. The Schools Division Offices shall submit the list of participants using the attached template on or before November 16, 2020 to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph.
8. Expenses incurred relative to this activity shall be charged against local/division/school fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

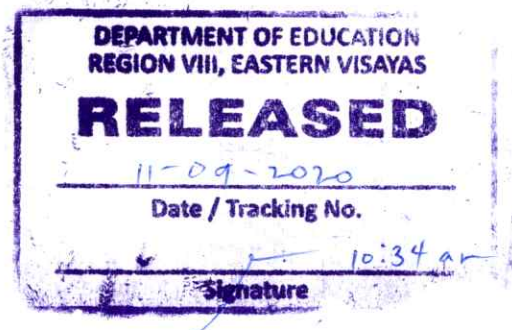
