3. The allotted number of participants to this activity is shown below:

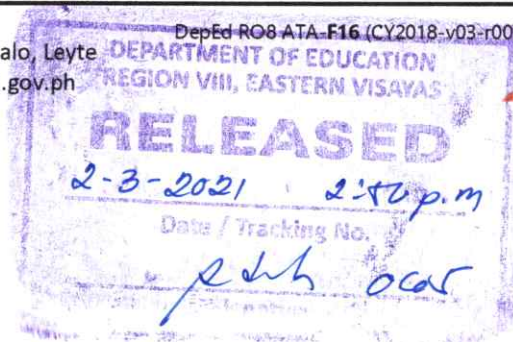
