

In the wake of COVID-19 pandemic, schools across the country face overwhelming challenges and difficult decisions in ensuring that learning continues to happen for our learners. Learning in the middle of a pandemic can be challenging, and this may result in varying levels of progress and achievement.

DepEd Order No. 031, s. 2020, also known as the *Interim Guidelines for Assessment and Grading in Light of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan*, was issued to help schools implement learner-centered practices for assessing and grading learners in different contexts. Assigning grades to learners during this period can be complex, but grades represent summaries of what learners have achieved academically so far.

To gain a deeper understanding of how our learners are doing as indicated by their grades, this Office respectfully requests the schools to provide elaborate data on learners' grades in the **First Quarter** of this School Year.
