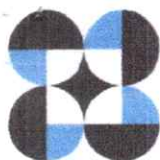

The Department of Science and Technology – Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) has opened its undergraduate scholarship programs for SY 2021, namely RA 7687 and Merit to senior high school students who wish to pursue four or five year courses in S&T fields.

The administration of the qualifying examination was scheduled on October 2020. However, due to the pandemic, it was postponed to a later date within the first semester of 2021. With the threat of COVID-19, especially with the emergence of the new variants in the country and in consideration of the safety of both the examinees and the testing personnel, the Advisory Committee on S&T Scholarships has approved the Non-conduct of Qualifying Examinations of the 2021 DOST-SEI S&T Undergraduate Scholarships.

This year, the grades of the applicants for the following shall be considered as one of the indicators in the selection and identification of the scholarship qualifiers, to wit:

Grade	Grades Covered
9	Average of first to fourth grading period
10	Average of first to fourth grading period
11	Average of first to second grading period (first semester) only

We would highly appreciate if you could provide us the form on or before **March 26, 2021** or inform/contact us if it is already available for pick-up. This would be a great help so we can fast track the processing and encoding of all the required data in the system on or before the deadline set by SEI which is on April 30, 2021.
