

days they will attend trainings/seminars during weekends and holidays, exclusive of the allowable 15 days for every year pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers* for their participation in SPFL-Japanese activities, provided that they have obtained prior authority to attend the training duly approved by their respective Schools Heads/Principals and Schools Division Superintendents.

6. SPFL Supervisors in the Regions and Divisions are reminded to closely monitor the program and the teachers' active participation and attendance, and to ensure the successful implementation of SPFL-Japanese together with our partner, The Japan Foundation Manila.
