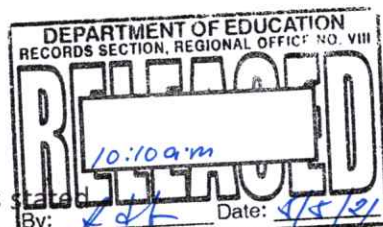

Lifestyle-related Disease
