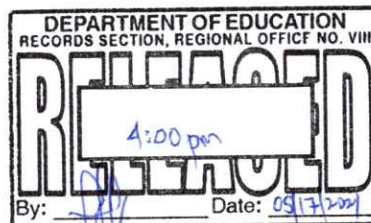

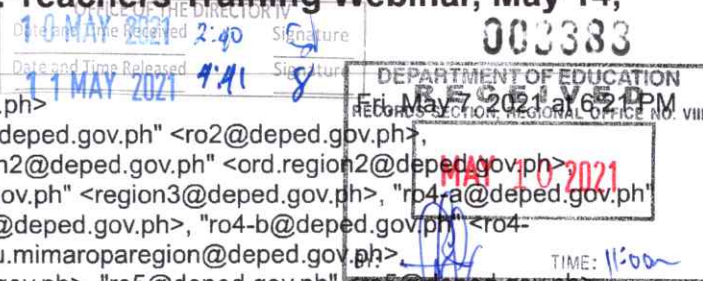

Dear DepEd Division Superintendents,

In relation to our previous letter dated 17 December 2021, Security Bank Foundation, Inc. in partnership with Knowledge Channel Foundation, Inc. 

(KCFI) and Ateneo de Manila University (ADMU), was able to produce **twenty (20) video lessons** in English for Grades 1, 3 and 5. These educational videos that may be used as supplementary learning materials for the teachers and learners focus on the following four (4) Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) in English:-

- Grade 1 - predict possible ending of story
- Grade 3 - make inferences and draw conclusions based on texts
- Grade 3 - interpret simple graphs, tables and pictographs
- Grade 5 - infer the meaning of unfamiliar words

Said videos will be launched on a staggered timeline from January to May 2021 aligned with their expected appearance on the MELCs covered based on DepEd's Academic Year Calendar. They will be made available for free use by everyone through the following mediums:

1. Television - Knowledge Channel in Cable Providers and A2Z Free Channel

2. Online – Security Bank, Knowledge Channel, and Ateneo websites, Facebook Pages and YouTube Channels
3. Offline – Uploading in Portable Media Libraries of Schools with Knowledge Channel TVs

There will be free Virtual Teachers' Training to provide teachers and other education stakeholders with a walkthrough on how to integrate the said videos in both distance and face-to-face modalities of learning.
