SECOND QUARTER VIRTUAL CONVERGENCE MEETING WITH THE CURRICULUM AND LEARNING MANAGEMENT DIVISION (CLMD) AND CURRICULUM IMPLEMENTATION **DIVISION (CID) CHIEFS AND EDUCATION PROGRAM SUPERVISORS (EPSs)**

Schools Division Superintendents To: All Others Concerned

- This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the Second Quarter Virtual Convergence Meeting with the CLMD and Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Chiefs and Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) on June 24-25, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. via Microsoft (MS) Team.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. shed light on the benefits of ALS Teachers and the need for accuracy of data submitted;
 - b. share observation and findings on the validation of DCLRs, onsite monitoring and evaluation of Special Curricular Programs (SCPs), and consolidated reports re: Program Implementation Review (PIR) on the utilization of Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) for the various distance learning delivery modalities as well as notable practices;
 - c. re-orient on the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Act;
 - d. discuss analysis of grade assessment results;
 - e. present updates on the implementation of the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs)/Individual Learner's Agreement (ILA), e.g. mastered and least learned competencies and percentage of competencies in the MELCs/ILA covered in every quarter per learning area across grade levels, including ALS, and on the Division Contextualized Learning Resources (DCLRs), Division Instructional Supervision Plan (DISP), and the Division Instructional Supervision and Accomplishment Report (DISAR);
 - f. conduct consultative meeting to monitor, validate, and provide technical assistance in the implementation of the Kto12 Basic Education, SCPs, Special Interest Programs (SIPs), Alternative Learning System (ALS), and Inclusive Education; and



- g. address issues, gaps, and concerns related to curriculum management and implementation based on the Regional Monitoring, Evaluation and Adjustment (RMEA) results.
- 3. The participants to this activity are the CLMD and CID Chiefs and EPSs. Other CLMD staff are also required to participate as support group. All the division participants shall register online using the link: https://bit.ly/3wmCRLY. The meeting access shall be shared to the CID chiefs through the Facebook Messenger.
- 4. The Schools Division Superintendents shall ensure 100 percent attendance of the expected participants.
- 5. For guidance, attached are the Matrix of Activities and the Presentation Guide. The SDOs shall submit the slide deck presentations on or before June 16, 2021 to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph.
- 6. Expenses incurred related to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


