1. This Office, through the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD), shall conduct the Eastern Visayas Innovation Summit on June 17-18, 2021 via MS Teams. The activity aims to provide an avenue for our educator-innovators to showcase their innovations developed and implemented in the school, division, and regional levels which address the needs of Basic Education in Region VIII.
2. All authors shall submit a 13-minute video presentation on or before June 16, 2021 by uploading it to this link: bit.ly/evis21vids. The official list of innovation presenters, the guidelines for the submission of video presentation, and the program of activities are enclosed herewith for reference.
3. All DepEd officials and employees who are interested to be part of this undertaking shall register as virtual audience through bit.ly/evis21reg on or before June 16, 2021. Only the first 50 registrants shall be invited to join the virtual conference.
4. Expenses for food (2 lunches and 4 snacks) of the Regional Office participants and other operational expenses relative to the Summit shall be charged to the PPRD Training Funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

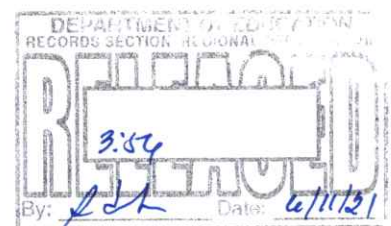

GUIDELINES

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 232 s. 2021 on the Call for Presentation of Innovations in the Region, a total of 99 project briefs have been received by this Office for screening.
2. All submitted project briefs had been categorized into four themes:
 - a. Curriculum, Teaching & Learning, and Learning Resources;
 - b. Planning, Monitoring & Evaluation systems, Research, and Technical Assistance;
 - c. Partnership & Linkages, Support to Health, and Disaster Risk Reduction Management; and
 - d. Governance and Leadership (Human Resource Development, Income Generation, and Administration).
3. A panel of evaluators has shortlisted the projects down to 24 notable innovations to be showcased during the Summit.
4. Enlisted Innovators shall present their Innovations through a recorded video presentation and are advised to show the gist of the following:
 - a. Rationale (Background, Objectives);
 - b. Procedure (Key Innovative Features, including the Persons Involved, Locale, Resources, Cost);
 - c. Impact to School and Community; and
 - d. Next Steps.
5. The video presentation shall not exceed 13 minutes having the presenter in front of the camera and voice over the PowerPoint or a combination of any other creative methods of presentation. The use of multiple screens and documentary styles are also allowed. The video must be in mp4 format and at least with a 720p resolution.
6. Authors shall submit the video presentation strictly observing the prescribed format by uploading them through bit.ly/evis21vids not later than **12:00 NN of June 16, 2021**. The file name must be in this format: <Category Code>_<Last Name of Author> example: CTL_Bautista. Complying authors shall be provided with a separate link for registration. Submission beyond the stated deadline shall no longer be considered. Failure to submit the required entries shall be ground for removal from the list of presenters.
7. Plaques of Recognition shall be awarded to all presenting authors.
