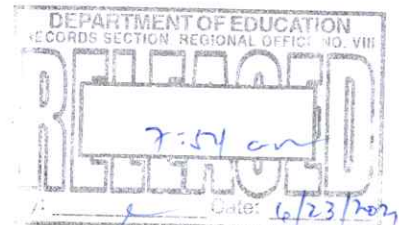

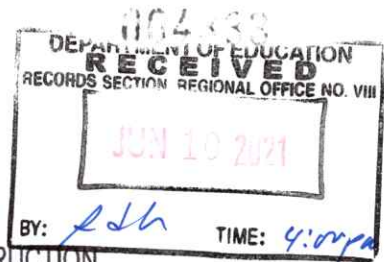

SUBJECT : **Space Education Survey of the Philippine Space Agency**

The Philippine Space Agency (PhilSA), the central government agency that addresses all national issues and activities related to space science and technology application, will conduct a **Baseline Assessment on Philippine Education** in coordination with the Department of Education. The survey will be used to understand the current context of space science in the basic education in terms of curriculum, extracurricular activities, teachers' capacity, students' interest, and career opportunities.

The outputs of the survey will also serve as reference of PhilSA in crafting recommendations to strengthen space science integration in DepEd's future curricular revisions as well as for developing public outreach and awareness activities and programs suitable for Philippine schools.

Two teachers per school shall be identified to answer the survey. The identified teacher-respondents shall be familiar with the K to 12 Science Curriculum Guide and the Science Curriculum as implemented in their schools. For Senior High Schools offering Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Strand, one respondent should be teaching STEM and the other is not.
