**DISSEMINATION ON THE OPENING OF CLASSES OF THE PRIVATE SCHOOLS,
STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCs), AND LOCAL UNIVERSITIES
AND COLLEGES (LUCs) OFFERING BASIC EDUCATION
FOR SY 2021-2022**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. With reference to DepEd Advisory to Private Schools and to Non-DepEd Schools on the Opening of Classes for SY 2021-2022 dated June 23, 2021, this Office, through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) announces to the field that Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) offering Basic Education shall be allowed to start their classes for School Year 2021-2022, provided that there are no face-to-face classes, and that the school shall be **strictly implementing only distance learning modalities**.
2. The authority to operate basic education of all Private Schools, SUCs and LUCs through the issuance of Provisional Compliance Certificate (PCC) to Offer Alternative Learning Modality/ies for School Year 2020-2021 will be extended for one (1) school year provided they have complied with the document requirements indicated in DepEd Order Nos. 013 and 017, s. 2020.
3. To ensure adequate preparation for School Year 2021-2022, all Private Schools, SUCs and LUCs are required to submit **Letter of Intent** (LOI) indicating the type of distance learning modality/ies to be offered and the date of the **opening of classes** with attached **School Calendar of Activities for School Year 2021-2022**. Said documents shall be sent to DepEd Regional Office VIII through records section using an email add: records.region8@deped.gov.ph. Deadline of submission shall be on or before **July 15, 2021**. **Submission beyond deadline shall no longer be accepted.**



4. Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) with approved Government Permit (GP) to offer Basic Education for School Year 2021-2022 not included in the Regional Memorandum 032, s. 2020 *re: Masterlist of Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) with Provisional Compliance Certificate to Offer Alternative Learning Modality/ies for School Year 2020-2021* shall be required to comply the documents stipulated in DepEd Order Nos. 013 and 017 s. 2020 for the issuance of the Provisional Compliance Certificate to Offer Alternative Learning Modality/ies for Basic Education for School Year 2021-2022 and shall submit the said documents **two (2) weeks** prior to their scheduled opening of classes.
5. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this memorandum are desired.



This Office, through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) announces the list of Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs') and Local Universities and Colleges (LUC's) with approved Provisional Compliance Certificate to offer Alternative Learning Modality/ies for School Year 2020-2021. These schools have successfully met the prescribed requirements of the Department of Education as stipulated in DepEd Order Nos. 13 and 17, s. 2020.
2. The masterlist in the attached enclosure shall be posted at the Regional Office, Division Offices, Municipal Halls, Schools and other conspicuous places that parents and general public will be able to track whether or not the school where their children are presently enrolled in is duly permitted by the Department.
3. The schools reflected in the masterlist of Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs') and Local Universities and Colleges (LUC's) with approved Provisional Compliance Certificate to offer Alternative Learning Modality/ies are the only schools authorized to accept enrollees and operate for School Year 2020-2021.
4. The Schools Division Superintendents and Education Program Supervisors In-Charge of the Private Schools, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs') and Local Universities and Colleges (LUC's) are directed to monitor the implementation of the Alternative Learning Modality/ies based on the standards and policy guidelines stipulated in the above – mentioned issuances.
