The City of Baguio was designated by UNESCO as a Creative City for Crafts and Folk Arts on 31 October 2017 – the FIRST Philippine City to be vested with the distinct honor of being part of the UNESCO Creative Cities Network's (UCCN) whose mission is to raise awareness on the power of creativity and innovation in building sustainable cities. In April 2019, the City Government of Baguio organized a multi-stakeholder participatory planning workshop to map out in more detail the commitments and plans of the City as UNESCO Creative City. The workshop participants collectively identified six (6) Key Result Areas (KRAs). This presentation aims to identify and discuss the outcomes, as of the present, more than three (3) years after the designation, even amidst the pandemic, based on the identified KRAs, the impact of these outcomes on the fostering of creativity as a driver for sustainable development and economic resiliency.
