



MALUNGGAY/MORINGA TREES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

In accordance with the DepEd Memorandum No. 234, s. 2008, "Planting of Malunggay Trees in Schools," all school administrators are encouraged to support the planting of malunggay or moringa trees in school premises and communities through integration in science classes and school community outreach projects.
