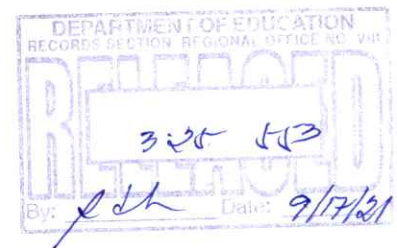

The Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) through the Special Curricular Programs Division (SCPD) shall monitor and evaluate the implementation of the most essential learning competencies (MELCs) of the Special Education (SPED) Program and the Special Curricular Programs (SCPs) namely: Special Program in the Arts (SPA), Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL), Special Program in Journalism (SPJ), Special Program in Sports (SPS), Special Science Program (SSP), and Special Program in Technical- Vocational Education (SPTVE).

The M&E activity shall be undertaken in reference to item no. 6 of DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2020 entitled *Adoption of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) for School Year (SY) 2020-2021 in Light of COVID-19 Public Health Emergency*, where the Curriculum and Instruction (CI) Strand is directed to monitor the implementation of the MELCs and evaluate its effectiveness in consultation with the regional directors. Ultimately, a report shall be submitted to the Office of the Secretary that shall be used to enrich the ongoing curriculum review. Hence, this Department encourages the full support of the field implementer.

The M&E is intended for teachers and school heads of SPED and SCP implementing schools. It is national in scope as it will cover the seventeen



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(17) regions and in consideration of the current situation due to pandemic, it will be conducted through an online platform.

The M&E objectives, schedule of activities for its completion, and other details are found in the succeeding pages.

The M&E aims to address the following objectives:

1. examine the sufficiency of the MELCs;
2. state the learning delivery modalities used;
3. identify the issues and challenges in the utilization of the MELCs; and
4. provide strategies that address the issues and challenges encountered.

In order to realize the aforementioned objectives, BCD identified preliminary and post activities to complete the M&E cycle and the links for the pre-registration and orientation as reflected in the table below:
