

ADOPTION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF BLENDED VALIDATION PROCESS (REMOTE AND ON-SITE) OF SCHOOL APPLICATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS/LUCs/SUCs, MERGING, CONVERSION, SEPARATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL ANNEXES AND RECOGNITION OF CURRICULAR SPECIAL PROGRAMS IN BASIC EDUCATION

- 1. To intensify the on-site validation process for the school applications as emphasized in the Regional Memorandum No. 000570, s. 2021 "Public and Private Schools for Ocular Inspection for Calendar Year 2021" dated September 28, 2021, and in consideration of the continuing health crisis due to COVID-19 pandemic, this Office, through the Quality Assurance Division, announces the "Adoption and Implementation of Blended Validation Process (Remote and On-Site) of School Applications for the Establishment of Public and Private Schools/LUCs/SUCs, Merging, Conversion, Separation of Public School Annexes and Recognition of Curricular Special Programs in Basic Education".

IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES OF BLENDED VALIDATION PROCESS (REMOTE AND ON-SITE)
OF SCHOOL APPLICATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND ADDITIONAL SENIOR HIGH
SCHOOL CURRICULAR OFFERINGS OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS/LUCs/SUCs,
MERGING, CONVERSION, SEPARATION OF
PUBLIC SCHOOL ANNEXES, AND RECOGNITION OF CURRICULAR
SPECIAL PROGRAMS IN BASIC EDUCATION

I. Rationale

Amidst the public health crisis brought about by COVID-19 pandemic, the Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office VIII through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) enhances the validation process of school applications through blended modality (remote and on-site), to ensure compliance with the requirements and standards set by DepEd.

The blended validation process is in compliance with the provision stipulated in DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020 "Guidelines in the Required Health Standard in Basic Education Offices and Schools."


II. Objectives

The blended validation process aims to:

- a. continually support to the engagement of the Department in the provision of access to basic education; and
- b. respond to the needs and requirements in addressing public health crisis, insurgencies and force majeure encountered by internal and external stakeholders through the use of technology.

III. Scope

These implementing guidelines of the blended validation process (remote and onsite) shall cover all school applications for the establishment and additional senior high school curricular offerings of public and private schools/LUCs/SUCs, merging, conversion, separation of public school annexes, and recognition of curricular special programs in basic education.





IV. Definition of Terms

For the purposes of these implementing guidelines, the following terms are defined operationally as follows:

- a. **Validation** is a process of verifying the relevance, accuracy, authenticity of school application submitted compliant with DepEd standards.
- b. Blended Validation is a combination of remote and on-site validation process to verify the school applications for the establishment and additional senior high school curricular offerings of public and private schools/LUCs/SUCs, merging, conversion, separation of public school annexes, and recognition of curricular special programs in basic education against standards.
- c. **Remote Validation** is an online/offline process of evaluating school applications. This involves the following sub-processes:
 - viewing the canned videos highlighting the school learning environment, physical facilities, and ancillary services based on DepEd standards;
 - ii. conducting distant Focus Group Discussion (FGD) using either internetdriven platform and/or audio conferencing through cellular phone; and
 - iii. viewing the live-videos if deemed necessary.
- d. On-site Validation is a process of evaluating school application that requires actual visit of the RIT/TWG to the schools applying for establishment and additional senior high school curricular offerings of public and private schools/LUCs/SUCs, merging, conversion, separation of public school annexes, and recognition of curricular special programs in basic education. This involves the following sub-processes:
 - i. conducting of ocular inspection to the school's learning environment, physical facilities, and ancillary services based on DepEd standards;
 - ii. conducting Focus Group Discussion (FGD) if needed; and
 - iii. validating/re-validating of non-compliance based on the findings of the RIT/TWG during the remote process.

V. General Guidelines



The following are the guidelines on how to conduct blended validation process (remote and on-site) of school applications in adherence to DepEd standards as basis for

recommendation for Regional Director's approval/disapproval.

PRE-VALIDATION

Remote Validation Process

School Applicant (SA)

- 1. Assign one focal person/in-charge per criteria in evaluation sheet;
- 2. The focal person/in-charge must be ready for the validation process with all possible means of communication;
- 3. Prepare canned video (maximum of 10 minutes) highlighting school's the learning environment, physical facilities, ancillary services and (classrooms. library, offices, clinic, canteen and others), and a well-defined school site boundaries.

Schools Division Office (SDO)

- 4. Submit online the following requirements to the Regional Office through e-mail account the Record Section records.region8@deped.gov.ph, five (5) calendar days prior to the validation schedule. Appropriately placed labelled all documents for submission in 3. Inform the School on the schedule of a file folder.
 - a. Contact Number of the following stakeholders
 - Brgy. Captain/Representative, School Head, Teachers, Learners (for SHS applicant only), PTA President/Representative, Municipal LGU Representative, Division Review and Evaluation Committee (DREC).
 - b. Canned video (maximum of 10 minutes)
 - c. Scanned copy of Signed Consent Form of stakeholders and parents of selected learners in disclosing his/her contact number, digital signature, information and his/her voluntary participation during validation.

On-Site Validation Process

School Applicant (SA)

1. Prepare the identified physical learning facilities (red flag/s) for validation/revalidation.

Quality Assurance Division (QAD)

- 2. Prepare the following:
 - a. Ocular Inspection Checklist;
 - b. List of school applicants;
 - c. Prepare Travel Order;
 - d. Itinerary of Travel;
 - e. Request for the use of government vehicle; and
 - f. Comply the travel documents required by Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF).

Schools Division Office (SDO)

- on-site validation; and
- 4. Organize the sequence of schools to be validated by the RIT/TWG as scheduled following the IATF protocols.

Moreover, he/she understand that any information derived will be used only for validation. Any information gathered in this validation shall be kept confidential in compliance with Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act.

- d. Digital signature of School Head of school applicant.
- 4.1 If the SDO failed to submit the online validation requirements within the timeline, automatically the application will be **RETURNED WITHOUT ACTION**.

 - ii. conducting Focus Group Discussion

On-Site Validation Process

RIT/TWG

- Meet the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) for protocol;
- Discuss with the SDS the purpose of the visit and the status of school applications;
- Request for DREC/SDO personnel to go with the RIT/TWG for the on-site validation;
- Travel to the applicant school;
- 5. Meet the School Head/Proponent;
- 6. Facilitate the on-site validation process.
 - i. Conduct ocular inspection
 - ii. Conduct Focus Group Discussion (FGD), if needed; and
 - iii. Conduct validation/re-validation of non-compliance based on the findings and recommendations of the RIT/TWG during the remote



- (FGD) using either internet-driven platform and/or audio conferencing through cellular phone; and
- iii. viewing the live-videos if deemed necessary;
- 4. Record the observations and findings in the Ocular Inspection Checklist;
- 5. Formulate recommendations and agreements;
- 6. Close the validation with SDO and school applicant; and
- 7. Facilitate the signing of the agreements as reflected in the accomplished Ocular Inspection Checklist.

- 2. Present the results of the on-site validation by the team leaders/co-team leaders:
