The Sustaining Education Reform Gains (SERG) Project would like to invite you to the Presentation of the Mapping Result on IP Learners, Learners with Disabilities (LWDs) and Learners in Difficult Circumstances, Teaching Practices, Teacher Professional Development (TPD) and Instructional Supervision (IS) in the Formal and Alternative Learning System (ALS) by the Alternative Resource School Philippines (ALRES-PHILS) on **04 November 2021** at **9:00am – 11:00am via Zoom**.

The study was conducted as part of the SERG Project's rolling baseline and as a follow-up on the Situational Analysis of Learners with Disability and Teacher Capacity in the Time of COVID-19 that was also conducted by ALRES-PHIL on July to August 2020. The mapping exercise was conducted from March 23 to June 07, 2021. A total of 1,149 respondents (1,100 teacher respondents, 49 ALS facilitator/mobile teacher respondents) from the 10 Schools Division Offices (SDOs) covered by SERG have participated in the mapping exercise, which aimed to respond to the following questions:

- 1. What is the general profile of IP learners, LWDs and learners in difficult circumstances in both formal and non-formal education?
- 2. What are the teaching practices, profile and context of teachers in formal and non-formal education (ALS) for school years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021?
- 3. How are teacher professional development and instructional supervision being done to address learner diversity and ensure learning continuity for all?

We would be delighted to present the findings of the mapping exercise and respond to pertinent queries from the Department of Education (DepEd) and other stakeholders prior to

the presentation to the Central Office and partnership meetings for collaboration for inclusive education.
