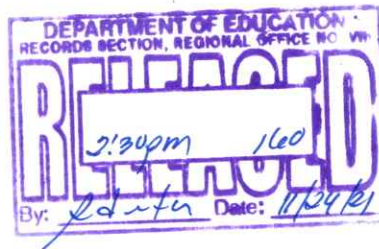

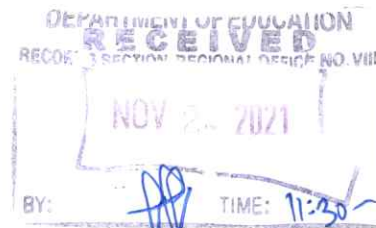

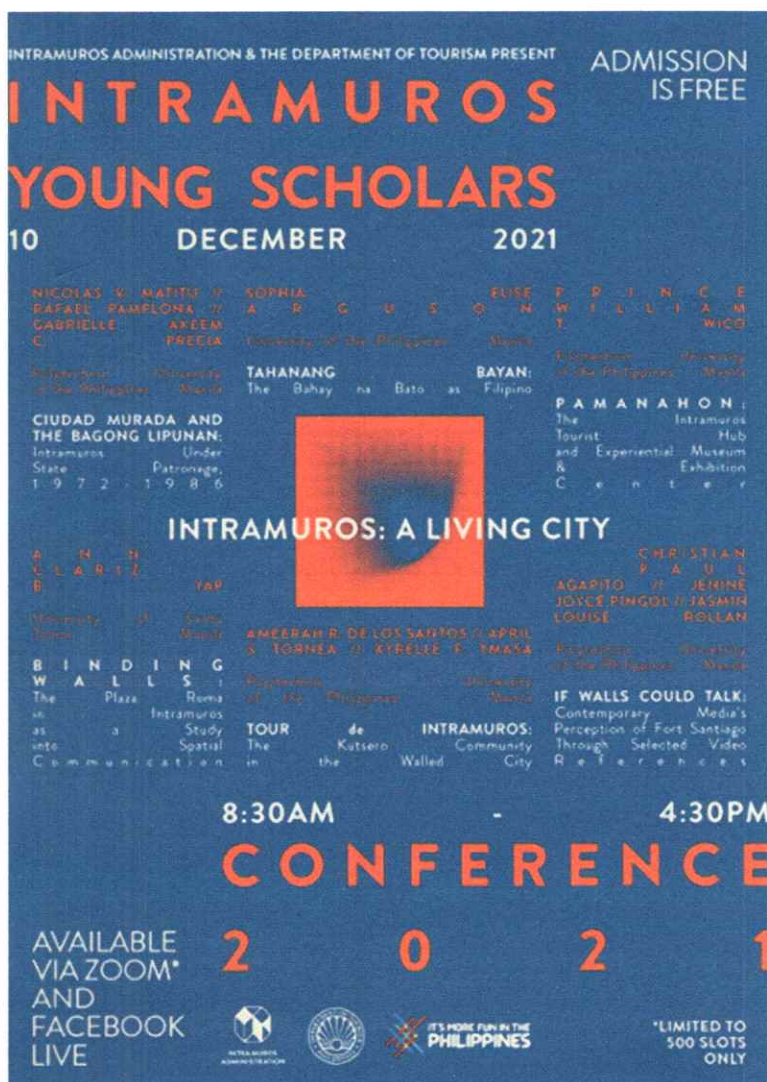


Intramuros: A Living City
