



The World AIDS Day is conducted yearly, on **01 December**, to raise awareness and knowledge, show support for People Living with HIV (PLHIV) and to make a call to end the HIV epidemic. It is also a celebration of the successes of all HIV stakeholders and the PLHIV community in their collaborative efforts to end the stigma and reduce the HIV infection in the Philippines.

The theme for 2021 is 'Ending the HIV Epidemic: Equitable Access, Everyone's Voice.' This is in line with the campaign of the Department of Health to enable Filipinos to have access to quality health care, which is mandated in the HIV and AIDS Policy and the Universal Health Care Act.
