1. In reference to the Regional Memorandum No. 755, s. 2021, re: Updates on the Conduct of the 10th ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition scheduled on December 13, 2021, the following items are embedded to wit:

- a. The 10th ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition shall be done online;
- b. In consideration of the needed strong internet connectivity, the rendition of the said activity shall be done at Rizal Elementary School Conference Hall, Tacloban City;
- c. The contestants and coaches shall pre-register online at <https://bit.ly/10thASEANQuizRegistration> on or before December 8, 2021;
- d. The simulation activity shall be conducted on December 10, 2021, three (3) days before the actual conduct of the Online Quiz. The meeting link will be shared through Group's Messenger of the Division Education Program Supervisors for Araling Panlipunan;
- e. The Division Education Program Supervisors for Araling Panlipunan and the Regional Education Program Supervisors shall monitor the division assigned to them per enclosure;
- f. The expenses incurred by the Regional and Division Monitors shall be charged against Local Funds, subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations;
- g. The Planning Conference of the Regional Management Team (RMT) and the Division Technical Working Group (TWG) will be held on December 3, 2021 at 9:00 AM, to discuss preparations relative to the conduct of the said activity. The meeting link will be shared through Group's Messenger;
- h. Strict adherence to national and local IATF protocols must be observed by the participants, members of the Technical Working Group (TWG), and Regional



- Management Team (RMT) when there is a need to meet face to face during meetings, rehearsals, and conduct of the online activity;
- i. Prizes for the 10th ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition are:
 - First Prize** - Php 5,000.00 cash (plus a Medal for the student, a trophy for the school and Certificate of Recognition for the coach)
 - Second Prize** – Php 3,000.00 cash ((plus a Medal for the student, a trophy for the school and Certificate of Recognition for the coach)
 - Third Prize**– Php 2,000.00 cash ((plus a Medal for the student, a trophy for the school and Certificate of Recognition for the coach); and
 - j. The contestants and coaches shall strictly observe the Contextualized Instructions, Guidelines, and Mechanics on the Conduct of the 10th ASEAN Quiz Online Regional Competition Process and the Activity Matrix attached hereto.
2. All other provisions in the abovementioned memorandum shall remain in effect.
 3. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

Contextualized Instructions, Guidelines, and Mechanics on the Conduct of the 10th ASEAN Quiz Online Regional Competition Process

The Curriculum and Learning Management Division shall adapt the Online Regional Competition Process to the contestants of the 13 divisions via Zoom or Google Meet Platform. This scheme is being employed as a proactive measure to facilitate a smooth proceeding of the competition during the time of emergency situations.

Before (Pre-online quiz)

1. The coaches and contestants shall be informed through text, call, or email at least two (2) days before the schedule of the Online Quiz and must prepare the following:
 - Desktop or laptop with camera, microphone, and speaker or a smartphone with Zoom or Google Meet application, and strong internet connection with at least 100mbps per second;
 - Zoom or Google Meet may be downloaded in the App Store or Google Play;
 - Active Gmail account or messenger account that are logged in during the entire process;
 - Markers, white board/white cartolina strip, and eraser provided by the coach to the contestant during the contest;
2. The host division shall send to the coaches and contestants the meeting link which should not be sent to anyone.
3. The SDO shall provide Gmail address and the complete name associated with the account/facebook messenger account or contact number to the Regional Management Team via email address at clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph.
4. The participants shall ensure that proper decorum and the following netiquettes are observed during the Online Quiz:
 - a. **C**hoose a Quiet Location with Good Lighting.
 - b. **O**bserve Appropriate Dress Code.
 - c. **V**ideo and Audio of Your Gadgets Must Work Properly. Test your microphone and camera. Battery must be full.
 - d. **I**nformation and queries must be related to the Online Quiz process.
 - e. **D**istractions must be avoided. Contestants shall use head phone/head set to avoid external noise. Turn on camera and microphone once the competition starts and for the whole contest duration.

During (Online Quiz Proper)

1. Contestants with their coaches shall be at their respective division's internet hub facilities on the day of the contest to avoid technical disruptions.
2. Contestants shall use the prescribed virtual background which will be sent to the Division AP EPS.

3. Each division shall send a one (1) minute pre-recorded video highlighting their local culture that will be used during the introduction of the participants. The pre-recorded video shall be uploaded to the google drive and send to the host division through Dr. Charlemagne Escobarte, Division EPS for Araling Panlipunan of Tacloban City Division.
4. Each contestant shall wear a school uniform and put on a sash with their assigned country per division as follows:

Tacloban City (Host Division) -Philippines	Leyte - Myanmar
Baybay City -Cambodia	Maasin City - Vietnam
Biliran - Indonesia	Northern Samar - Brunei
Borongan - Timur	Ormoc City - Burma
Calbayog City – Singapore	Samar – Brunei Darrusalam
Catbalogan City – Malaysia	Southern Leyte - Thailand
Eastern Samar – Laos	
5. The coaches and contestants shall click the link provided in order to be admitted by the Host.
6. Once all contestants and coaches are admitted or when the exact time to start is reached, the Quizmaster shall request the contestants to turn on the camera video on their surrounding and to share their screens to ensure that there are no materials or other persons that might distract them during the actual online quiz.
7. The Online Quiz process shall start with the following parts:
 - a. Preliminaries
 - i. Opening Program
 - ii. Press Conference
 - b. Quiz Proper
 - i. Welcome Message
 - ii. Acknowledgement of participants through 1 minute introductory video, reading of the Contest Guidelines and Mechanics, Introduction of the Quiz Master and the Board of Judges
 - iii. Presentation of ASEAN Quiz Proper
8. Contextualized Contest Mechanics of the 10th ASEAN Quiz Online Regional Competition:
 1. The 13 student-participants from the 13 divisions shall compete individually in two segments.
 2. The two (2) segments are as follows:
Segment 1: *True or False and Multiple Choice*
Segment 2: *Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion*
 3. Segment 1: The True or False part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. The Multiple-Choice part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given 1 point. **Total score is 20 points.**

4. Segment 2: The Fill in the Blanks or Completion will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given 3 points. **Total score is 60 points.**
5. **The total points for the Competition is 80.**
6. The contestants shall be seated comfortably in individual chairs with armrest.
7. Each contestant shall be provided with a white board or cartolina strip, a marker and an eraser to be used in answering the questions for Segments 1 and 2. Participants will write their answers on the whiteboard or cartolina strip.
8. For **Segment 1 (True or False and Multiple Choice)**, participants will write the word True or False for the True or False questions and write the letter of the correct answer for the Multiple Choice questions. Participants will be given **10 seconds** to write down their answer.
9. For **Segment 2 (Fill in the Blanks or Completion)**, participants will be given **15 seconds** to write down their answers. A buzzer shall indicate that the time is up. Answers should be written in full; with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the given time allotment.

Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say '**GO**'. Only then will the participants write their answer. When the time is up the Quizmaster will say '**Markers Up**'. Participants will then hold up their markers and whiteboards or cartolina strip to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. The scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before moving on to the next segment.

10. The Organizing Committee and Sub Committee on Test Development and Quiz Mechanics shall provide technical support and clarification deemed necessary by the Board of Judges.
11. **Scoring Systems.** There will be two scoring systems to ensure correctness of tabulations to be handled by the Regional ASEAN Quiz Scoring Team in cooperation with the Host Division ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee. These two scoring systems are: (1) electronic via computer, and (2) manually, using scoring sheets and a tabulation board prominently displayed for the reference of the 13 contestants, the Board of Judges, coaches and other guests.
12. After the completion of **Segment 2**, the cumulative points earned by each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined and verified by the 10th Regional ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee. When the results have been verified, these will be submitted to the Board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.

13. The Chairman of the Board of Judges shall declare the First, Second and Third place Winners. The three highest pointers shall represent the Region in the 10th ASEAN Quiz Competition. The Fourth-place winner shall be declared as the alternate team member in case anyone of the three winners will be unable to go to Manila for the 10th ASEAN Quiz Competition.
14. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner/s shall emerge. At the start of the tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero.
15. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.

1. Pursuant to the attached DepEd Memorandum No 076, s. 2021, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division and in coordination with the Tacloban City Division as the host division, will conduct the 10th ASEAN Quiz Regional Competition on January 10, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom online platform.

2. The activity aims to foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN youth in a friendly quiz game that exposes them to ASEAN cultural, political, economic and social information.

3. The target participants to this activity are the Division contestants, coaches and facilitators as shown on the table below:

4. The contestants in this Regional competition must:
- be currently enrolled in Grades 9 to 10 between 15-17 years old and must not be 18 old by the time of the Regional Competition in the first quarter of 2021;
 - come from either a public or private school;
 - be proficient in the English language, both oral and written;
 - have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies, during the first quarter of S.Y.2021- 2022;
 - be physically and mentally fit;
 - have good interpersonal skills/ be a good team player;
 - be willing (with parental consent) to travel to Quezon City for the National Level Competition and for the Regional Competition in Myanmar in 2022; and
 - meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee Philippines.

5. All the Division Araling Panlipunan Coordinators are required to submit their Division Entries with duly accomplished Student Information Sheet with the scanned copy of certificate of Live Birth, Report Card reflecting the grades for the first and second grading, School ID, and Parent's Permit as proof of the criteria set earlier on or before January 4, 2022 through email at clmd.deped.gov.ph.

6. There is no registration fee. However, honorarium of the Board of Judges and all other expenditures incurred relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the downloaded fund per OSEC-8-21-3091 and OSEC-8-20-1166 which shall be further transferred to the host division, and expenses of the division participants to the Local Funds/ MOOE or any available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

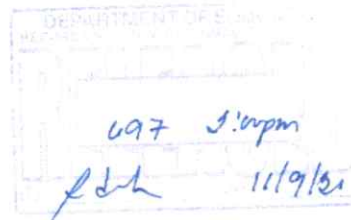

10th ASEAN QUIZ NATIONAL COMPETITION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division Superintendents
Public and Private Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. The **10th ASEAN Quiz National Competition** with Myanmar as host country, will be conducted by the People's Television Network (PTN), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd), the Department of Foreign Affairs (DEA), the Presidential Communication Operations Office (PCOO), the Philippine Information Agency (PIA), and the Philippine Broadcasting Service (PBS) from **March 8 to 11, 2022**.
2. The ASEAN Quiz is a continuing project of the ASEAN Committee on Culture and Information (COCI) that aims to foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN youth in a friendly quiz game that exposes them to ASEAN cultural, political, economic and social information.
3. The ASEAN Quiz (Regional Level) participated in by the 10 ASEAN member countries (Vietnam, Cambodia, Philippines, Malaysia, Brunei Darussalam, Thailand, Lao PDR, and Singapore) shall be preceded by the National Level Competition.
4. The National Level Competition to be held at PTV Broadcast Center, Visayas Avenue, Quezon City shall be participated in by the regional winners. The three winners in the National Level Competition shall be the Philippine representatives to the 10th ASEAN Quiz to be hosted by Myanmar in the third quarter of 2022.
5. In the event of COVID-19 resurgence, the competition will then be shifted to online platform in which a separate memorandum will be released.
6. In connection with the National Level Competition to be held on **March 8-11, 2022** at PTV Broadcast Center, Quezon City, the DepEd regional and schools division offices are encouraged to conduct the search **through online competition from October 2021 to February 2022**. The name of the winner shall be submitted to the Office of the Director, Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), Attention: Mr. Rowel S. Padernal at telefax numbers (02) 8632-7746 and (02) 8635-9822 or email at rowel.padernal@deped.gov.ph not later than February 15, 2022.
7. The student-participant in the National Level Competition must
 - a. be in Grades 9 to 10, between 15 and 17 years old and must not be 18 years old by the time of the Regional Competition in the third quarter of 2022;
 - b. come from either a public or a private school;

- c. be proficient in the English language, both oral and written;
- d. have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies during the first quarter of School Year 2021-2022;
- e. be physically and mentally fit;
- f. have good interpersonal skills/be a good team player;
- g. be willing (with parental consent) to travel to Quezon City for the National Level Competition as well as for the Regional Competition in Myanmar in 2022; and
- h. meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee Philippines.

8. The expenses to be incurred during the regional and division search shall be charged to local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

9. For the National Level Competition in Quezon City, accommodation, food and local transportation of one student representative from each of the 17 regions shall be covered by the project fund, while all other expenses by the teacher-coaches, including the airfare of the student representative shall be charged to local or other sources of funds.

10. For the three winners in the National Level Competition who will represent the Philippines in the 10th ASEAN Quiz in Myanmar in 2022, airfare, accommodation, food, and local transportation shall be covered by the project fund.

11. Enclosed are the implementation guidelines, contest mechanics, program of activities and the student information sheet that must be accomplished by the student regional representative.
