
- 1. In line with the expansion of the limited face-face classes, this Office, through the Quality Assurance Division, hereby informs the field for the Submission of the List of Private and Public Schools Ready for the Expansion of the Limited Face-to-Face Classes Implementation comes January of 2022.
- 2. This Office, likewise, reiterates that all private and public schools shall assess and comply with all the requirements based on the indicators and standards stipulated in the School Safety Assessment Tool (SSAT) including the concurrence of the Local Government Unit and the parents' consent in the preparation for the expansion of the limited face-to-face classes.
- 3. Moreover, all schools shall accomplish the said SSAT Form through <a href="https://tinyurl.com/RegionVIII\_SSAT">https://tinyurl.com/RegionVIII\_SSAT</a> which must be validated and verified by the concerned SDO Composite Team.
- 4. The Schools Division Superintendents shall ensure that all schools are provided with technical assistance in compliance with the above-mentioned form.
- 5. An Enclosure No. 1 is hereby attached in this memorandum which shall serve as a data gathering template to be used during the progress monitoring and be submitted weekly in the QAD Email address: <a href="mailto:qad.region8@deped.gov.ph">qad.region8@deped.gov.ph</a>. Deadline for submission on the List of Private and Public Schools Ready for the Expansion of the Limited Face-to-Face Classes Implementation shall be on or before **5:00 p.m. of** January **10, 2022,** through the QAD email address mentioned above. **Late submission shall no longer be accepted.**


