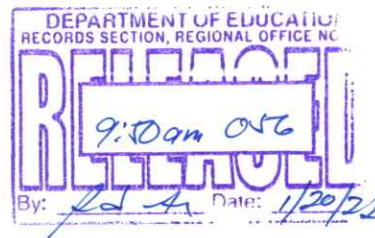

Subject: **GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION, DOCUMENTATION, AND REPORTING OF FUNDS DOWNLOADED FOR THE CLEAN-UP AND MINOR REPAIR OF SCHOOLS AFFECTED BY TYPHOON "ODETTE" (BATCH 3)**

Typhoon (TY) "Odette" has brought massive destruction to many parts of Visayas and Mindanao, and the education sector is not excluded. To support the response operations and immediate learning continuity of the affected regions and divisions, P10.04 million from the Disaster Preparedness and Response Program (DPRP) of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) shall be downloaded for the clean-up and minor repair of affected schools.

Implementing Guidelines on the Utilization, Documentation, and Reporting of Funds Downloaded for the Clean-Up and Minor Repair of Schools Affected by Typhoon "Odette" (Batch 3)

1. The fund support for clean-up and minor repair shall be allocated to affected regions as follows:

No.	Regions	Amount (P)	Fund Source
1	VI	5,660,000.00	
2	VIII	4,380,000.00	
Total		10,040,000.00	

2. The funds may be used for the following:
 - minor repair of damage classroom/s (e.g., replacement of roofing, repair or replacement of damaged window/door, etc.);
 - purchase of the replacement of damaged equipment or furniture (e.g., printer, copier, chairs, tables, etc.)
 - purchase of equipment to be used in cleaning the school ground (e.g., power sprayer, chainsaw, power tools, etc.)
 - repair of the drainage system, water system or electrical wiring;
 - Salary/ies of manpower; and
 - other expenses related to the clean-up and minor repair of school.
3. For documentation and monitoring, the affected regions and divisions are required to do the following:
 - consolidate completion reports and photo documentation;
 - consolidate and archive certification of submitted liquidation reports;
 - coordinate with the Division Finance Office for other needed liquidation requirements;
 - accomplish the Fund Support for Clean-Up and Minor Repair Monitoring Template attached in this Memorandum; and
 - submit photos, completion reports and accomplished monitoring template to the DRRMS.
4. The Regional and Division Budget Officers in coordination with the Regional and Division DRRM Coordinators shall submit to DRRMS (drmo@deped.gov.ph) the status of fund utilization using the attached template.
5. All expenses shall be subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, auditing and procurement rules and regulations. Misuse and/or mismanagement of these funds for the purpose other than those authorized in this set of guidelines is strictly prohibited. Any violation committed by any individual or group will be dealt with in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. The judicious utilization of the fund is expected. Obligation, implementation and payment shall be compliant to Executive Order (EO) No. 91, titled *Adopting the Cash Budgeting System Beginning Fiscal Year 2019, and for Other Purposes*.
