

# TRAINING ON EXECUTIVE EDUCATION IN LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT: MORAL LEADERSHIP AND RESILIENCE WITH STRONG EMPHASIS IN CONFLICT RESOLUTION, DECISION MAKING AND BALANCE

To: Schools Division Superintendents Regional Office Division Chiefs All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office, through the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) shall conduct a limited face-to-face training on EXECUTIVE EDUCATION IN LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT: Moral Leadership and Resilience with strong emphasis in Conflict Resolution, Decision Making and Balance for the Regional Office Chief Education Supervisors, Education Program Supervisors, HRDD Senior Education Program Specialist and Education Program Specialists II, and three (3) Grievance Committee Members from each of the thirteen (13) Schools Division Offices on February 23-25, 2022 at the RELC, NEAP-R VIII.

The activity aims to enhance understanding on leadership, leadership development and management, and the elements of team effectiveness; develop skills on the different techniques in decision making, social graces, and etiquette; and appreciate one's skills and values from his/her intelligences.






to this Office (2021 Continuing), subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
