CORRECTION OF SCHOOL NAME ON RECORDS OF SAINT JOSEPH COLLEGE, MAASIN, LEYTE

- 1. In reference to the approved Amended Articles of Incorporation by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) with Company Registration No. 4281 of Saint Joseph College, Maasin, Leyte of Maasin City, Southern Leyte dated June 11, 2015, the Department of Education Regional Office No. VIII through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) announces the correction of school name on records from **St. Joseph College- High School Department** in the issued Government Recognition on April 1, 2001 and **St. Joseph College** in the Enhanced Basic Education Information System (EBEIS) to **Saint Joseph College, Maasin, Leyte** effective March 23, 2022.
- 2. The correction of name does not instill any deviations on the provisions of the Government Recognition given to the said school. Thus, the Government Recognition No. 006, series of 2002 for the secondary level still remains legal and official.

- 5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.




