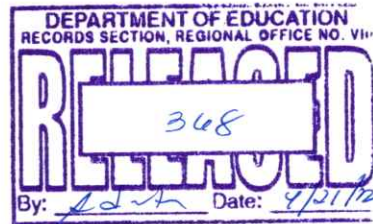
1. In compliance with DepEd Memorandum, dated March 21, 2022 re: National Invitational Sports Competition (NISC), this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby announces the attached composition of the Official Delegation to the National Invitational Sports Competition for Sepaktakraw on April 26-28, 2022 in Zamboanga Del Norte Convention Center, Dipolog City.
2. It is recommended that there shall be only one Travel Order (TO) for all the participants indorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent and duly approved by the Regional Director per Regional Memorandum No. 537, s. 2019, entitled Dissemination of DepEd Order No. 22, s.2019, re: Guidelines on Official Local Travels in the Department of Education.
3. It is advised that the concerned Schools Division Office (SDO) should guarantee that no classes will be left behind and should be managed by available teacher/s who will replace the coach involved in the said sports competition to ensure that students still obtain the full benefit of the curriculum-based instruction. Student-athletes shall be given additional merits for their attendance to the said activity. They shall be allowed reasonable time to make up and comply with other requirements of the different subject areas including but not limited to quizzes and other examinations that they will miss.
4. There shall be no registration fee, however, traveling expenses of participants going to and from the venue and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds/MOOE or other sources of fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The participants to this activity who travel or render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays can avail of the Service Credits, CTO or COG equivalent to eight (8) hours of service per day whichever is applicable per DepEd Order No. 67, s.1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.



6. The Regional Official Delegation shall be adherent with the specified protocols and guidelines per Alert Level pursuant to the IATF-MEID Resolution No. 164-D entitled Guidelines on the Nationwide Implementation of Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response.

7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

DATE : **21 March 2022**

1. The Philippines, through the Department of Education (DepED), in coordination with the local governments of Dumaguete City and the Province of Negros Oriental, and DepED Region VII, will host the **12th ASEAN Schools Games (ASG)** scheduled from November 19 to 28, 2022 in Dumaguete City.
2. In connection to the Philippines' participation in the aforementioned international school sports competition, the Bureau of Learner Support Services–School Sports Division (BLSS–SSD) shall conduct a **National Invitational Sports Competition (NISC)** for the seven (7) sports events to be played in the ASG namely Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, *Sepaktakraw*, Swimming, Table Tennis, and Volleyball.
3. The Competition shall serve as an alternative avenue in the efficient and effective identification and selection of student-athletes in the absence of an organized school sports tournaments or competitions such as the *Palarong Pambansa* due to the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
4. The primary objective of the NISC is to identify and select the finest and most athletically-talented secondary school student-athletes who shall form part of the Philippine delegation and compete against athletes from other ASSC member-countries.
5. The Competition venues, schedules, and the billeting schools of student-athletes and team officials are as follows:

6. All concerned are enjoined to provide the necessary support and assistance to the participating student-athletes, including DepEd personnel who will serve as technical officials (referee, judges, umpire), coaches, chaperon, and members of the various technical working committees.

7. DepEd personnel who will serve as technical officiating officials and perform game-related administrative work shall secure an official travel authority from their respective station. Proof of vaccination such as vaccination cards or DOH-issued vaccination certificates and a medical certificate must be presented upon registration.

- b. Tournament Guidelines, and Rules and Regulations for each of the seven (7) sports events; and

9. All expenses relative to the conduct of the NISC shall be charged to the 2022 Physical Fitness and School Sports Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
