MONITORING ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROJECT ARM (ARMY OF READING MENTORS) UNDER THE REMEDIATION READING PROGRAM OF THE FOOD FOR THE HUNGRY (FFH), PHILIPPINES, INC. AND SUBMISSION OF DATA ON THE LEARNERS' READING PROGRESS

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. To ascertain the successful implementation of Project ARM (Army of Reading Mentors) under the 6-month Reading Remediation Program of Food for the Hungry (FFH), Philippines, Inc., this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in collaboration with the FFH and Leyte Division, shall regularly monitor the progress of the said reading project in the recipient-schools in La Paz Districts, La Paz, Leyte within the entire duration of the implementation.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. track the reading progress exhibited by the learner-recipients;
 - b. provide needed technical assistance to the Learner Support Aides (LSAs);
 - adjust reading strategies and materials based on the results of the learners' performance and feedback by the LSAs; and
 - d. harvest good stories, challenges, and opportunities needed for the documentation of the project.
- 3. Moreover, the Division MTB-MLE Focal Person, through the School Reading Coordinators of the identified school-beneficiaries, is required to update the Google Sheet on the learners' reading progress by accessing the link shared via Facebook Messenger Group Chat. The spread sheet includes, among others, details of the learners and assessment results with the pre-test (Beginning of School Year -BoSY CRLA), in-between assessments (Early Grades Reading Assessment-EGRA and other formative/teacher-made literacy test), and the post-test (End of the School Year (EoSY) CRLA).
- 4. Frequent interfacing between and among the teacher-advisers, LSAs, DepEd Leyte Division and Regional Office, and the sponsoring organization is considered pivotal in this endeavor, hence, a meeting shall be held monthly by the FFH as the lead. A separate issuance shall be released regarding the needed regular meeting.



 - d. sustain the commitment of the teachers, learner-support aides, and other stakeholders on the successful implementation of the reading remediation program.
- The participants to the activity are the Members of the Technical Working Group whose names are listed in the enclosure, District Supervisors of La Paz District, School Heads and teachers from the participating schools, and the staff and LSAs from the Food for the Hungry, Phil., Inc.
- The participants are reminded to observe the health and safety protocols released by 4. the Local IATF such as wearing of mask and face shield during the entire duration of the activity, frequent handwashing or sanitizing of hands using alcohol, and social distancing, among others.
