4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

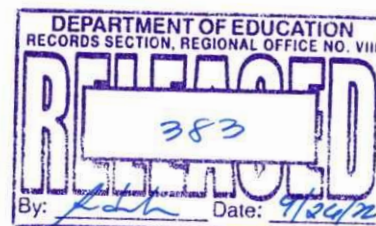
