

3-DAY LIVE-IN REGIONAL DIVISION-BASED DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (RPD) FOR SCHOOL HEADS AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS (BATCH 2) AND 3-DAY LIVE-IN REGIONAL-DIVISION REGIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS (RTOT) FOR THE SCHOOL HEADS, SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS, TLE, ESP, SCIENCE, AND MATH TEACHERS OF SDO CALBAYOG CITY

- 1. With the successful conduct of the first batch of the Regional Development Program and Training of Trainers to identified Master Teachers I-III and Teachers I-III of the Schools Division Office (SDO) Calbayog City on February 21-26, 2022, this Office, through the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) in collaboration with Curriculum Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the second batch of the 3-day Live-in Regional Division-Based Development Program (RDP) and Training of Trainers (ToT) for the School Heads, Senior High School Teachers, TLE, EsP, Science, and Math Teachers of SDO Calbayog City on May 23-28, 2022 at a venue to be announced later.
- 2. This RDP and ToT still hold the same aim to respond to improving school heads and teachers' emerging developments in professional development which can support the realization of the Department's goal of continuous upskilling and reskilling of teachers which will eventually result in better learning outcomes.
- 3. The host division shall identify its participants who are fully vaccinated coming from the 12 districts of the Schools Division of Calbayog City including the facilitators/trainers/resource speakers. Likewise, participants must observe the City IATF protocol and standards like social distancing, wearing of face mask, constant washing of hands with water, or rubbing alcohol.
- 5. All expenses incurred by school heads and teacher participants such as registration fees, traveling, and all other expenses shall be charged or reimbursable to school MOOE/PTA/or other sources of funds, while travel and other incidental expenses of the division management team, facilitators, resource speakers, and class managers shall be charged against division/CID/SGOD MOOE, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
