



DOWNLOADING OF FUNDS TO THE SELECT SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES AS AN AUGMENTATION TO THE EXISTING TRAVEL FUNDS IN SUPPORT TO THE PARTICIPATION IN THE NATIONAL TRAINING FOR SPEAKERS BUREAU ON THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR)

To: Schools Division Superintendents
(Divisions of Baybay City, Borongan City, Leyte,
Ormoc City, Samar, Southern Leyte, and Tacloban City)
All Others Concerned

- 1. In support to the Participation in the National Training for Speakers Bureau on the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and with the prevailing oil price hike that has eventually caused in the increase of the transportation cost, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Finance Division (FD), shall download funds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php100,000.00) through a funding check arrangement from the savings of the Downloaded 2021 ALS Program Support Funds (PSF) with the Sub-ARO Number OSEC-8-21-2610, to the select Schools Division Offices as an augmentation to the existing travel funds, following the breakdown specified in the enclosure.
- The funds shall be used to help defray the travelling and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants relative to their attendance in the abovementioned activity.
- 3. The Schools Division Superintendents concerned, through the Chiefs of the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall submit a financial report on the utilization of the downloaded funds not later than **June 30, 2022** to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph cc alfredo.cafe@deped.gov.ph.







- 4. Further, there shall be a regional monitoring which must include the progress checking of the previous downloaded funds for the ALS Program implementation to enhance the absorptive capacity of the Schools Division Offices, chargeable against the downloaded ALS PSF.

This Office, through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) conducted the first leg of Roadshows on the ALS Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) in the 12 project sites of Opportunity 2.0 with support from the USAID and the Education Development Center (EDC) from March to April 2022.

The next leg of the Roadshow will be conducted in other Regions nationwide. The BAE will conduct the National Training of Regional Core of Trainers for the ALS Act and its IRR – Speakers Bureau in three (3) clusters:

The abovementioned national training aims to: s

- a) update and make the ALS Regional Core of Trainers (Speakers Bureau) knowledgeable about the provisions of R.A. 11510¹, also known as the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);
- ensure that members of the Speakers Bureau are available in each region/division to inform, update and answer queries from the Department of Education, partners, and stakeholders; and
- c) establish a stronger linkage between the DepEd central and field offices in implementing and delivery of the ALS programs.

¹ An Act Institutionalizing the Alternative Learning System in the Basic Education for Out-of-School Children in Special Cases and Adults, and Appropriating Funds Therefor, Section 24 on the Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Transportation expenses, board and lodging of all management staff, participants, trainers/resource persons, other expenses for supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses relative to the activity will be charged against 2022 FLO-ALS Continuing Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The travel expenses of the participants in all activities covered in this Memorandum will be downloaded directly to the SDOs except for BARMM, where participants' transportation allowance will be directly downloaded to the Regional Office of BARMM and will be paid in full upon submission of the travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Teaching and non-teaching personnel attending the said workshop will be entitled to service credits pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 67, series 2021 on the Amendment to DepEd Memorandum No.65, s. 2021 (Clarificatory Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers for School Year 2021-2021 In Light of the Covid-19 Pandemic) and per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 entitled Non-Mandatory Remuneration for Overtime Services, whichever is appropriate and applicable.
