

PHILIPPINE SCIENCE CENTRUM TRAVELING EXHIBITS: A SCIENCE TEACHERS' TRAINING

To: Schools Division Superintendents Divisions of Eastern Samar and Northern Samar All Others Concerned

- This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in partnership with the Philippine Foundation for Science and Technology (PFST), will conduct the Philippine Science Centrum Traveling Exhibits: A Science Teachers' Training on July 20 -21, 2022 for Eastern Samar Division and on July 27 – 28, 2022 for Northern Samar Division.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a) develop and promote Science and Technology through various educational programs and projects;
 - b) capacitate Science teachers on the teaching strategies and the use of laboratory boxes containing the Science Centrum-based activities complemented by the teacher's guide and manual; and
 - c) discuss challenges and interventions and provide technical assistance relative to Science education program implementation.
- The participants are the Regional and the said Divisions' Science Education Program 3. Supervisors and Division-identified elementary and secondary Science teachers. A total of 130 participants per division shall attend, with 65 participants per day.
- 4. The identified Schools Division Offices shall provide the venue, audio-visual resources needed for the training, and accommodation arrangement of the participants. Likewise, they shall also organize their Technical Working Group (TWG) to facilitate the smooth conduct of the activity from registration, attendance, distribution of kits to evaluation, and other trainingrelated concerns.





- 5. Strict adherence to National and local IATF protocols must be observed in the conduct of the face-to-face training such as, but not limited to the mandatory wearing of mask, disinfection mechanisms, and physical distancing, by all participants and members of the Technical Working Groups.
- 6. The TWG and the participants involved in this activity who shall render services, report for duty, or accomplish work beyond office hours such as on weekends, school year vacation, or holidays in the exigency of service shall earn service credits subject to the existing and applicable rules and regulations.
- 7. There shall be NO registration fee. The expenses related to the conduct of the training such as food for lunch and two snacks and training materials shall be charged to the PFST funds, while other training-related expenses such as travel and incidental expenses shall be charged against local/Division/school MOOE or other funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Dear Director Fetalvero:

Warm greetings from the Philippine Foundation for Science and Technology (PFST)!

The PFST is a non-stock, non-profit organization mandated to develop and promote science and technology through various educational programs and projects like the Philippine Science Centrum and its traveling exhibitions, teachers' training, science related projects, events, competitions, research and development, design and fabrication of interactive science exhibits.

Through the years, the partnership of DepEd and PFST serves as a good model of public-private partnership. In the 90's, the Department of Education has designated PFST as lead agency of "Science for All Project" sponsoring and implementing various science educational programs.

In 2021, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) sponsored the PFST project dubbed as "Philippine Science Centrum Traveling Exhibits: A Platform for Promoting Science Interest among Students in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas" where the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) was chosen as beneficiary region. Ninety thousand (90,000) grade 5 -12 students in three thousand (3,000) public schools had the opportunity to watch the video based exhibits of Philippine Science Centrum exhibits. Five hundred (500) teachers were trained via online webinar using the lab boxes containing Science Centrum based activities complemented by teacher's guide and manual. All learning resources are based on DepEd's Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELC) curriculum.

Some highlights of the project evaluation conducted by PFST Education Consultant are the following:

- Results of the student survey that applied both quantitative and qualitative measures indicate a positive impact of the exhibit videos on a large percentage of students.
- Teacher comments point out the high quality and usefulness of the videos as teaching-learning tool

As Dr. Yul V. Olaya, Division Chief of Curriculum and Instruction Division of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education-BARMM said "The outcome of

this project both the online webinar and PSC video based exhibits for students proved us wrong that online training will never be successful. So far, this PFST project proved otherwise. Teachers learned more with a great resource speaker supported by resource materials all free of charge."

For Year 2, **Region VIII** is identified as one of the beneficiary regions particularly the provinces of *Eastern Samar* and *Northern Samar*. In 2018, these two provinces were also recipients of our Traveling Science Centrum benefitting combined visitor attendance of over 100,000.


In this view, PFST would like to seek an audience with you and your official representatives of the abovementioned provinces/ divisions via zoom meeting to further discuss the project and its details.
