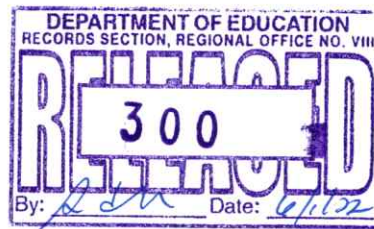



The Department of Education (DepEd), through the External Partnerships Service (EPS), in collaboration with the Project Management Service (PMS), has conducted the Parent-Teacher Associations (PTA) Forum on DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2022 titled "Omnibus Guidelines on the Regulations of Operations of PTAs" last April 19, 2022.
