Kasaysayan bilang Aral ng Kinabukasan"*** on August 31, 2022, 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM via Zoom.

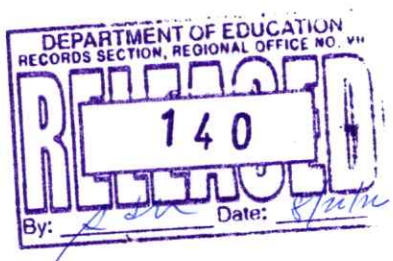

The webinar will be on August 31, 2022 (Wednesday), 1:00PM to 5:00PM. It will be held via Zoom, and it will be livestreamed in our Facebook page and YouTube channel.
