In reference to DepEd Memorandum OM-BAE-PQAD-2022-019 dated August 2, 2022, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby requires all divisions to do a **Weekly Updating on the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Enrollment Quick Count for School Year 2022-2023** starting **August 11, 2022** thru a link which shall be shared later at the Facebook Group Chat of the Division ALS Focal Persons.
2. The Schools Division Superintendents, through their respective Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Chief, shall ensure that the updating of the enrollment would be accomplished by either the Division ALS Focal Person or the Education Program Specialist for ALS (EPSA) only, as emphasized in Paragraph 4 of the aforementioned DepEd Memorandum.
3. All other details on this undertaking are stipulated in the above-mentioned DepEd Memorandum.
4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

This has reference to DepEd Order No. 035, s. 2022 titled Guidelines on Enrollment for School Year 2022-2023 in the Context of Re-Introduction of the In-Person Classes, particularly **Item A 2.b** which states that "There will be a daily reporting of enrollment count and the summary result of Enhanced Basic Education Enrollment Form (BEEF) and ALS Modified AF-2 from the start of enrollment period until one month after the opening of classes using the Quick Count Facility in Learner Information System (LIS).

Please be informed that the development of the Quick Count Facility for ALS in the LIS is still ongoing. In lieu of the said facility, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) is introducing Google Sheets with data elements similar to that in the Quick Count Facility.

In connection to this, may we request the Regional ALS Focal Persons to disseminate to their Division ALS Focal Persons the Google Sheets, and regularly monitor the online submission of enrollment quick count reports per Schools Division Offices (SDOs) using the Google Sheets.

The Division ALS Focal Persons and Education Program Specialist II for ALS (EPS II for ALS) are required to accomplish and regularly update the Google Sheet every Thursday of the week. To protect the integrity of the data, sharing the link with teachers in ALS in their respective SDO is strictly prohibited and will be detected by the BAE and by the Regional ALS Focal Person.

The BAE technical staff in charge per region shall send through email the link for the Google Sheets. They shall monitor online the everyday enrolment of ALS per program, and generate the weekly enrolment report every Friday morning. A consolidated

report will be submitted by the BAE to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for ALS. The report will also be posted on the ALS 2.0 Facebook page. Further, kindly remind the concerned field officials that the BAE is required to submit enrolment data for the Beginning of School Year (BOSY) to the Office of the Planning Service. Similar to the definition of BOSY in the formal school system, it refers to a period in the LIS facility to encode, update and complete the enrollment data and learner information requirements for the corresponding School Year. Hence, regular online monitoring of enrollment quick count and registration of learners in the LIS is important.
