FOR SCHOOL TRANSPORT SERVICES**

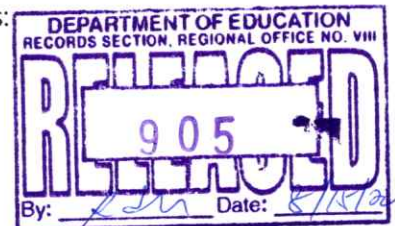

Greetings!

In anticipation to the resumption of face-to-face class this August 22, 2022 under Department of Education No. 034, Series of 2022, the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board has allowed the resumption of School Transport Service Operations to provide sufficient transport services.

Based on our records, there were about 14 School Transport Services operating with valid permits within the Leyte. Those who failed to renew their permits during pandemic years may avail of the waiver of penalties under MC 2022-066.

As one of the requirements to operate, School Transport Service operators are required to secure endorsements from the schools valid Parent-Teacher Association or School Certification/Endorsement Letter Authorizing/Accrediting the School Service. They are also required to send their units to our Office in Palo, Leyte for inspection.

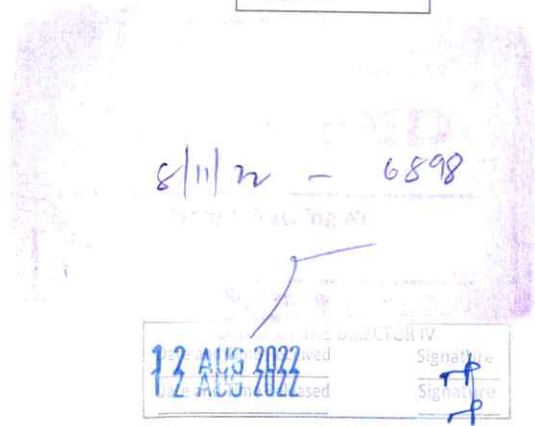
In view of this development, we would like to request our office to remind all schools under your supervision to be aware of the requirements for School Transport Services for their students. We are also sending similar reminders to private schools whose students are to avail of such mode of transportation.
