

DOWNLOADING OF FUNDS TO THE HOST SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES IN SUPPORT TO THE MASS TRAINING OF ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) IMPLEMENTERS AND ALS PARTNERS ON THE ALS ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

To: Regional Division Chiefs
Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- 1. To Ensure the high probabilities of participation and to minimize the travelling expenses of the target beneficiaries which include the external stakeholders during the conduct of a *Regional Mass Training of Alternative Learning System (ALS) Teachers and ALS Partners on the Implementation of the ALS Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR)*", this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Finance Division (FD), shall download funds to the recipient Schools Division Offices through an issuance of Sub-ARO the amount following the breakdown specified in the enclosure amounting to Two Million Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (Php2,332,800.00) from the 2022 Downloaded ALS Funds intended for the above-mentioned activity for the ALS, bearing the Sub-ARO Number OSEC-8-22-3430 dated 16 May 2022.
- 2. The above-mentioned funds shall be used to cover expenses incurred in the procurement of the board and lodging of the participants, travel expenses of the DepEd personnel, reproduction of materials, printing of certificates, conduct of meetings/orientations and other activities relative to the implementation of the ALS Act and its IRR for the Fiscal Year 2022.
- 3. The concerned Schools Division Superintendents, through their respective Chiefs of the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall submit a financial report on the utilization of the downloaded funds not later than December 31, 2022 to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph cc alfredo.cafe@deped.gov.ph.





- 4. Further, there shall be a regional monitoring and technical assistance provision by the fourth quarter, through any authorized modality, to check the status of the previous downloaded funds intended for the ALS Program implementation to enhance the absorptive capacity of the Schools Division Offices.
- 5. All expenses incurred during the conduct of the regional monitoring shall be charged against the downloaded 2022 Program Support Funds for the ALS.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.


