4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

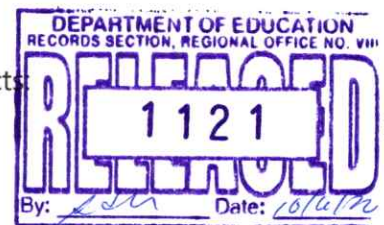

Relative to the invitation to regions for the **expansion of the Special Program in Foreign Language-Korean (SPFL-Korean)** per BCD-SCPD-O-2022-2959, the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Curriculum Development-Special Curricular Programs Division, in partnership with the Korean Ministry of Education and the Korean Cultural Center through the Embassy of the Republic of Korea, is pleased to announce the **schools that passed the evaluation and the Batch 5 teachers who passed the interview** who shall participate in the virtual **Korean Language Training Program** in preparation for their implementation of SPFL-Korean.

As scholars, the teachers are expected to sign the SPFL commitment form and complete the said Korean language training and other capacity-building activities in the future, such as, but not limited to, immersion program and refresher training.

In addition, recognizing the efforts of the teachers, they are eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 5, s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.
