**CONDUCT OF REGIONAL FEDERATED SUPREME PUPIL GOVERNMENT (SPG) AND
 SUPREME STUDENT GOVERNMENT (SSG) ELECTIONS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022 titled: "School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023" dated July 11, 2022, the Supreme Pupil Government (SPG) and Supreme Student Government (SSG) Elections should have been conducted on September 5-16, 2022. However, due to the ongoing transition of schools from blended learning to face-to-face modality, and maintaining the contact time of teachers to learners, a Memorandum from Dr. Dexter A. Galban, Assistant Secretary, Youth Affairs and Special Concerns, dated September 23, 2022, reset the dates of the elections. Along this line, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD)- Special Programs and Projects Section (SPPS) shall conduct a face-to-face elections of the Regional SPG and SSG Federated Officers on **October 24, 2022** at the RELC-NEAP Mess Hall, DepEd Regional Office Complex, Government Center, Candahug, Palo, Leyte.

2. The objectives of this activity are the following:

- a. establish student representations through the SPG/SSG in the Regional level; and
- b. ensure maximum participation of all student-leader participants.
