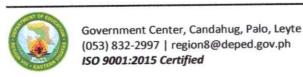

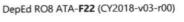

- 2. SLP participants must capture their answers to the guide questions through a video or PowerPoint presentation and delivery of a written speech.
- 3. The time allotment for the presentation is as follows:
 - a. 10 15 minutes WAP presentation and delivery of speech
 - b. Five minutes for clarifications and feedback from invited guests, SLP fellows, and partners
- 4. It is important to present the following:
 - a. Background and challenges of the division and purpose of the programs initiated.
 - b. Extent or progress of the implementation including the initial gains or results, and
 - c. Integration of learnings from the program
- 5. The following are the guide questions for the speech:
 - a. What are the lasting lessons that the SLP has given you? How did you apply the lessons gained from SLP? Give concrete examples.
 - b. How did these lessons affect your division/schools? Give concrete examples.
 - c. What are the SLP-initiated ideas that you have successfully implemented? How are you "passing the lessons on" to the next generation of DepEd leaders you are now managing and leading?
 - d. After joining the SLP, what are the changes in your perspective as a leader?
