5. The lesson of the demonstration teaching should target any of the Most Essential Learning Competencies found in the 2nd Quarter.
6. The video demonstration teaching must be submitted on or before November 4, 2022, through <https://forms.gle/ryFEAPtu4Cmu7bLZA>
7. Lastly, the identified teacher shall prepare and submit a semi-detailed lesson plan, following the 4As (Activity, Analysis, Abstraction, and Application), together with the video demonstration.
