- 6. The video demonstration teaching must be submitted on or before November 4, 2022, through https://forms.gle/ryFEAPtu4Cmu7bLZA
- Lastly, the identified teacher shall prepare and submit a semi-detailed lesson plan, following the 4As (Activity, Analysis, Abstraction, and Application), together with the video demonstration.
