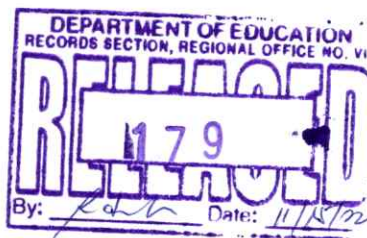

b. ALOYSIAN PUBLICATIONS is a private and independent, national and international award-giving body, duly recognized by the Philippine Government.


