



During the recently concluded Meeting with the National Reading Program (NRP) Technical Working Group (TWG), conducted through **DepEd Memo No. BCD-CSDD-O-2022-3403** re: Invitation to the Meeting with the NRP TWG and Consultation with Reading Specialists, the need to gather data on the most current reading programs implemented across governance levels was established. Guided by the reading specialists, the TWG developed a survey tool that will examine the said initiatives, the results of which shall inform important decisions in the crafting of the National Reading Program.
