### **GUIDELINES FOR VIDEO PRESENTATIONS**

- Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 1206, s. 2022 on the Call for Presentation of 1. Innovations in the Region, 97 project briefs have been submitted for screening.
- All submitted project briefs had been categorized into four: 2.
  - a. Curriculum, Teaching & Learning, and Learning Resources;
  - b. Planning, Monitoring & Evaluation systems, Research, and Technical Assistance;
  - c. Partnership & Linkages, Support to Health, and Disaster Risk Reduction Management; and
  - d. Governance and Leadership (Human Resource Development, Income Generation, and Administration).
- A panel of examiners shortlisted the projects down to 24 notable innovations that shall 3. be showcased during the Summit.
- Enlisted Innovators shall present their Innovations through a recorded video 4. presentation and are advised to show the gist of the following:
  - a. Rationale (Background, Objectives);
  - b. Procedure (Key Innovative Features, including the Persons Involved, Locale, Resources, Cost);
  - c. Impact to School and Community; and
  - d. Next Steps.
- The video presentation shall not exceed 13 minutes having the presenter in front of the camera and voice over the PowerPoint or a combination of any other creative methods of presentation. The use of multiple screens and documentary styles are also allowed. The video must be in mp4 format and at least with a 720p resolution.
- Authors shall submit the video presentation strictly observing the prescribed format by uploading them through bit.ly/evis22vids not later than 12MN of December 19, 2022. The file name must be in this format: <Category Code>\_<Last Name of Author> example: CTL\_Bautista. Complying authors shall be provided a separate link for registration. Submission beyond the stated deadline shall no longer be considered. Failure to submit the required entries shall be ground for removal from the list of presenters.
- Plaques of Recognition shall be awarded to all presenting authors. 7.
